UNIFORM + RECYCLING = UNICYCLE

UniCycle is a school clothing recycling program that collects and distributes “outgrown, not worn out” items to MNPS students. Since our school has a looser dress code, we collect what we wear - jeans, joggers, t-shirts and hoodies! Donations will fill our school's UniCycle Closet, then extras will go to the Homeless Education Resource Office for Families in Transition (HERO Program) or be sent to another UniCycle school with our same dress code. We are part of a network across MNPS that works together to ensure each school closet has what students need!

WHAT WE COLLECT

Gently-used (or new!) clothing that meets dress code requirements! Clean out closets– it will all be put to use by students who will start their day with comfort and confidence.
